



**MentorConnect Privacy Policy
As of 10/11/2009**

1. No information you share with MentorConnect will be sold, rented or given to any other company for commercial use.
2. No MentorConnect participants will be contacted by MentorConnect or its sponsors, for anything other than communications about mentoring/community service sessions, unless you have chosen to accept these types of communications, by checking the box on the registration form.
3. Any research conducted for demographic information will be done without the use of personal information. It will be important to measure the success of the site and to make changes based on how users interact with the site, but none of these reports will include personal information.
4. No child's information will be given to anyone other than name, age and subject of choice. The parent has the responsibility to share any other information with the mentor/community service partner.
5. No child, under the age 13, should sign up on MentorConnect. The parent or guardian signing up will provide their own email, phone number and other information.
6. When a match is found, the parent will be contacted. The parent will decide the best way to contact the mentor.
7. Once sessions begin, the parent will decide how many contact options will be shared.
8. MentorConnect does not recommend the child giving the mentor his/her own email address or phone number. MentorConnect does not recommend sharing of social networking information such as Facebook or MySpace. MentorConnect is not responsible for this activity or outcomes of this activity.
9. If a session ends due to some kind of difficulty, MentorConnect will ask all parties to sign a waiver stating that they will not contact each other. If contact takes place after this point, MentorConnect cannot be held responsible for the communication or anything occurring due to this communication.
10. Any emails sent should include info@MentorConnect.net as a recipient.
11. No communications other than having to do with the sessions should be in any emails or phone conversations to and from mentors or other parties involved with this program.
12. Any issues between mentoring/community service participants should be communicated to MentorConnect as soon as possible so they can be dealt with appropriately.
13. Mentors, Students and Parents agree not to share each others contact information with others.
